

Budget

- Tuition : waived for exchange students
- Student health insurance (social security) : free
- Liability insurance : ~30€ / year
- Rent: from 500 to 800€ / month (6万円~10万円)
- Food : min 200€ / month (2万5千円)
- Transportation: 350€/year (4万5千円)


