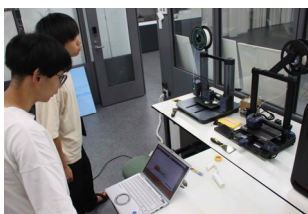

From August 2 to August 9, 2 2nd year students, 32 3rd year students, 12 4th year students, and 29 TA students participated in the Asian University Design Workshop at the open space on the 6th floor of the main building on the Toyosu campus. This year's theme was omamori (talisman), and we worked on designing objects to protect someone or something. Twenty-one U O U students from Korea, 15 from K M U T T, Thailand, 15 from P S U from Korea, 15 from Thailand, 15 from K M U T T, and 8 from Chiba University, 93 students were divided into 18 teams and enjoyed 8 days of activities. They also deepened their understanding of Japanese culture by visiting shrines in Asakusa and various other locations.
