Scholarship of encouragement for Master's program admission

1. The purpose of the Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial support for outstanding Bachelor students at Shibaura Institute of Technology who advance to the graduate school of this university.

2. Eligibility of Application

As of April 1, 2025, this scholarship is open to students enrolled in their fourth year in the College of Engineering, College of Systems Engineering and Science, College of Design Engineering or School of Architecture at Shibaura Institute of Technology who wish to advance to the university's Master's program through departmental recommendation. Applicants must be recognized as outstanding in both academic performance and personal qualities and must have applied for the scholarship in accordance with the application procedure.

3. Duration and Disbursement Method of the Scholarship

The scholarship period is generally for the duration of two years during enrollment in the Master's program. The method of disbursement involves deducting the half-yearly scholarship amount from the semester's tuition fee payment.

4. The Number of Pre-Scholarship Recipients and the amount of Disbursement

Applicants for this scholarship will be selected based on their academic records, in the order of Type A, Type B, and Type C, within their respective departments and programs. Applicants cannot choose their scholarship type, and they will not be selected for multiple types simultaneously.

5. Application Procedure

- (1) Application Method: Enter the required information on the designated form "Scholarship Application" in the online application system [The Admissions Office (TAO)]. Uploading documents is not necessary.
- (2) Application Period : April 15, 2025(Tue) 12:00PM ~

 May 9, 2025(Fri) 4:00PM (Strict adherence)

(period for accepting Department Recommendation Selection).

(3) Notes: Those who wish to apply for this scholarship must submit an application. If there are any deficiencies in the information provided, the applicant will be disqualified from the scholarship selection process. Even during the application period, once the application is completed, modifications or changes to the application details are not allowed. Therefore, please ensure that there are no omissions or errors in the application content before submitting the application.

6. Selection and Decision for Pre-Scholarship Recipients

- (1) Based on academic records (such as Weighted average score based on credits in each department/program at the end of the third year), top-performing applicants who meet the scholarship selection criteria will be selected within their respective departments and programs. The selected candidates will be reviewed by the Graduate School Master's Program Scholarship Selection Committee, and the final decision on the recipients will be made by the university president.
- (2) Regarding the accepted applicants, the announcement of successful candidates will be made on the university's website (ScombZ) at the time of the announcement of admissions decisions (July 10, 2025, Thursday).
- (3) The accepted candidates are referred to as "Pre-Scholarship Recipients."

 By enrolling in the graduate school Master's program at our university,

 Pre-Scholarship Recipients become scholarship recipients.
- (4) If any of the following conditions (i, ii, or iii) are met during the disbursement period of this scholarship, the scholarship will be discontinued, resulting in the cancellation of acceptance. Furthermore, if you are certain at the time of application that you will meet any of these conditions upon admission to the master's program, you will not be eligible for selection and must indicate this in your application.
 - i Students who do not pay tuition fee by own such as MEXT or JICA
 - ii Students who are receiving other scholarships or financial aid that cannot be received concurrently.
 - iii Students Who do not wish to receive a scholarship.
