



Waterford

- Waterford city has won the Irish Times Best Place to Live in Ireland contest 2021. 1.
- Waterford is a city in the south-east of Ireland. Waterford City is over 1100 years old and it is the 2. oldest and the fifth most populous city in the Republic of Ireland. According to the 2022 census, 60,079 people live in the city, with a wider metropolitan population of 82,963.
- Waterford city is very student friendly city, and has a wide variety of restaurants, bars and cafes. 3.
- With 147km of coastline any visit to Waterford wouldn't be complete without visiting a beach. 4. Waterford's beaches, in addition to nestling in the warm heart of the Sunny South East, are some of the most beautiful in the country, and also includes a 46km cycle greenway.
- There are regular transport connections to other major cities from Waterford. 5.

Modules / Courses

- Students can study in SETU Waterford for a Semester only Semester 1 (September December) or 1. Semester 2 (January – May), OR for the full Academic Year (September – May)
- Modules that are available to our International Exchange can be found in the ECTS Module Guide 2.
- The number of lecturer hours for each module is between **3-4 hours per week**. 3.
- We usually give students 2 weeks to figure out the modules they wish to take for the semester, 4. taking into account timetable clashes and module capacity before we register them on their modules.
- 5. You can **only** take modules that are available **during the current study semester.**
- You must choose a minimum of 3 modules and a maximum of 6 modules, in any one semester. 6.
- **Please be advised** the maximum number of ECTS credits you can study per semester, at SETU is 30 7. credits and the minimum is 15 credits. The majority of modules at SETU are worth 5 ECTS.

SETU Disability Service

There are many supports available to students with disabilities in SETU. To avail of supports, students are invited to register with the Disability Office and participate in a needs assessment.

- 1. The English as a foreign language module at SETU is worth 5 credits.
- 2. Taking English Language as a module is not mandatory. If you do wish to take this module you must also request approval from your home university to add this to your learning agreement.
- 3. Please be advised that attendance is mandatory for all lectures. If you are unsure of which language level to choose, please go to the first class, introduce yourself to the lecturer and ask them which level would be most suited to your English language proficiency.

Challenges for international students

- Accommodation As there been an increase of students in need of accommodation over the last decade, it is getting increasingly more difficult to secure student accommodation throughout Europe.
- Language Barrier A student may struggle to understand instructions and grasp concepts in the classroom and may need extra time and support to complete tasks.
- **Culture Shock** which can cause feelings of uncertainty, confusion, or anxiety after they arrive in Waterford.
- Engagement We encourage students to join clubs and engage with other students, and to step outside their comfort zone.

SETU Office for International Relations is available to all International students for any queries or concerns they may have during their stay in Waterford.



Preparing Students for their arrival to SETU Waterford

- From Application to Arrival, we have open communication with all students.
- We currently run four Online Pre-Arrival Informal Chats several weeks before the students arrive in SETU Waterford. This is an excellent way for students to ask about non-academic topics, such as weather, food and fun things to do in Waterford and Ireland. By engaging in these chats, students also get to meet and talk with other students before they arrive in Waterford.
- We offer two mandatory Orientation Programmes, online and inperson. During the online Orientation, students will hear from different Schools, Departments, Clubs and Societies and is a fantastic opportunity to become familiar with the services/ supports available as a student of SETU. The in-person Orientation is a great way to meet their fellow students and take a guided campus tour.
- We also run Continuous Orientation Wellbeing programmes throughout the semester.



• All non-EU students must apply for the Irish residences permit within 90 days of arriving in Ireland. We can provide information and assistance for this process.
