2024 年度グローバル理工系人材育成大学院給付奨学金 募集要項 秋入学者用

1. The purpose of the Scholarship

The promotion of Cultivating Global Engineering talent and the encouragement of university department students and graduates to pursue graduate studies.

2. Eligibility of Application

Students who are currently undergraduate at our university or who have graduated Bachelor's degree from our university, and who are planning to enter the Graduate school Program in the Faculty of Engineering in the 2024 academic year, and who meet the following criteria:

* Regular Undergraduate Students of SIT:

Students who have a TOEIC score of 550 or above by the day before the enrollment date of the Graduate School

* Graduates of SIT's Undergraduate Program:

Students who submitted a TOEIC score of 550 or above at the time of entrance examination application.

(Regular Undergraduate Students/Graduates of Sit's Undergraduate Program refers to the status of applicants as current students or graduates at the time of application for entrance examination.)

3. Duration and Disbursement Method of the Scholarship

The scholarship period is generally set for the duration of two years during enrollment in the Master's program. The scholarship amount is set at an annual rate of 300,000 yen. For students entering Graduate School in April, 300,000 yen per year will be offset from the tuition fees for the second semester of the first year of the Master's program and the first semester of the second year of the Master's program, respectively. (*For students entering Graduate School in October, adjustments will be made accordingly for the transition period, and the initial offset will be applied to the tuition fees for the first semester of 2025)

4. The Number of Selection

The maximum number of new scholarship recipients per year is set at 600. However, there may be cases the number of recruits exceeds the maximum limit per year.

5. Application Procedure

Those who meet the application requirements will automatically be considered for

the scholarship selection through the following procedure.

<**Regular Undergraduate Students of SIT>

Those who have a TOEIC score of 550 or above, in the 'approved' status in the S*gsot Portfolio by the day before the enrollment date, will automatically be considered for the scholarship selection.

For any inquiries regarding the registration process, approval, registration deadline, etc., for the S*gsot Portfolio, please contact the Global Section of SIT.

< Graduates of SIT's Undergraduate Program >

Those who have submitted a TOEIC® L&R score report of 550 or above at the time of entrance examination application will automatically be considered for the scholarship selection. Scores from the TOEIC-IP test taken at SIT are included in the automatic application. Scores taken after enrollment in the university are also considered valid. *When applying, please input your student ID number at the time of graduation in the "Admissions Application" on TAO.

<**The Approach to S*gsot Portfolio registration for regular Undergraduate Students of SIT and the day before enrollment varies>

For example, if the enrollment date for graduate school is October 1, 2024, then September 30, 2024, would be the day before enrollment. Under this system, Students holding TOEIC scores (TOEIC® L&R, IP test) of 550 or above in the "approved" status on the S*gsot Portfolio by the day before enrollment will automatically be considered for this scholarship. Scores from internal IP tests will be automatically registered, but for scores from official tests taken externally, individuals must register them and obtain approval themselves. For inquiries regarding S*gsot Portfolio score registration, including deadlines, processing time for approval and required documents, please contact the Global Section.

6. Selection and Decision

- (1) The selection of scholarship recipients will be conducted based on the scores of applicants who have been automatically considered for the scholarship.
- (2) Only students who have selected will be notified of the selection results. (For October Graduate School Entrants, notifications are scheduled to be sent via Scombz by December of the first year of the Master's program.)
- (3) This scholarship allows for concurrent use with the following scholarships.
 - * Mater's Program Enrollment Incentive Scholarship
 - *JASSO (Type 1) (Loan, without interest)
 - * JASSO (Type 2) (Loan, with interest)
