The Global Project-Based Learning (PBL) program was held in Bangkok, Thailand, jointly organized by Kasetsart University and Shibaura Institute of Technology. The participating students from Shibaura Institute of Technology, mainly from the Departments of Materials Engineering and Applied Chemistry, formed mixed teams with KU students and engaged in collaborative PBL activities. Divided into six research groups, the students conducted experiments and analyses, and presented their outcomes in English on the final day. During the program, they visited the Isuzu Motors Thailand plant, where they observed production lines designed to meet local market needs. In addition, Thai language lessons, a Muay Thai workshop, and a Thai cooking class were offered, providing valuable opportunities for cultural exchange.
