The 14th South East Asian Technical University Consortium (SEATUC) is scheduled to be on the 27th - 28th February 2020 at Knowledge Exchange for Innovation (KX) building, King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi. The prominent researchers, engineers and practitioners who serves as faculty members of SEATUC member universities are cordially invited to submit their research to be presented at the symposium.

1) Oral Presentation session (Full-paper peer-reviewed)

Authors are invited to submit complete unpublished papers in English. Submission should be in form of a PDF file with a maximum paper length of six (6) printed pages (10-point fonts) including figures, in accordance with SEATUC author guidelines. Submitted papers will be peer-reviewed at least two reviewers. Only the accepted papers can be presented in the session as oral presentations and published in SEATUC 2020 proceedings. Authors of selected papers will be invited to submit extended versions of their papers to SEATUC Journal of Science and Engineering (SJSE).

The topics of interest include, but are not limited to, the following items:

- 01: Mechanical Engineering and Robotics
- 02: Materials and Chemistry
- 03: Electrical and Electronic Engineering, ICT, and Computer Science
- 04: Architecture, Design, Planning, and Civil Engineering
- 05: Bio/Life Science
- 06: Engineering Education
- 07: Basic and Applied Mathematics and Numerical Simulation

2) Poster Presentation session (Abstract reviewed)

SEATUC 2020 also includes Poster Presentation session in which researchers can present and discuss their work-in-progress, ideas, ongoing research, and experimental studies. Authors are requested to submit 1 page extended abstract (with one figure accepted) in form of a PDF file, which are then reviewed. The authors of accepted abstracts can submit their final manuscripts by the Camera-ready paper due in form of a PDF file with: 1) the same format as the technical session up to four (4) pages, or 2) 6-up printed PowerPoint slides, or 3) 1-page poster presentation format, which are published in SEATUC 2020 proceedings. Namely, authors can choose three types of format. The papers in this session are presented as poster presentations.
