The following changes will be effective from AY2024 entrance examination. Details will be announced in the application guidelines for each examination, so please be sure to check it for the year of application before applying.

Special Selection for Foreign Students/Working Adults for Fall Enrollment *Eligible from the examination for AY2024	Entrance Examination for Fall Enrollment (General Program · Program for Working Adults) *Eligible from the examination AY2024
