## Anomaly detection

- · Anomaly score represent the how the image is different from dataset
- Residual loss is the difference between test and Generated image
- Discrimination loss is the difference between test and Generated feature vector
- Our setting  $\lambda = 0.8$

Anormaly score =  $(1 - \lambda) * residual Loss$ + $\lambda * discrimination Loss$
