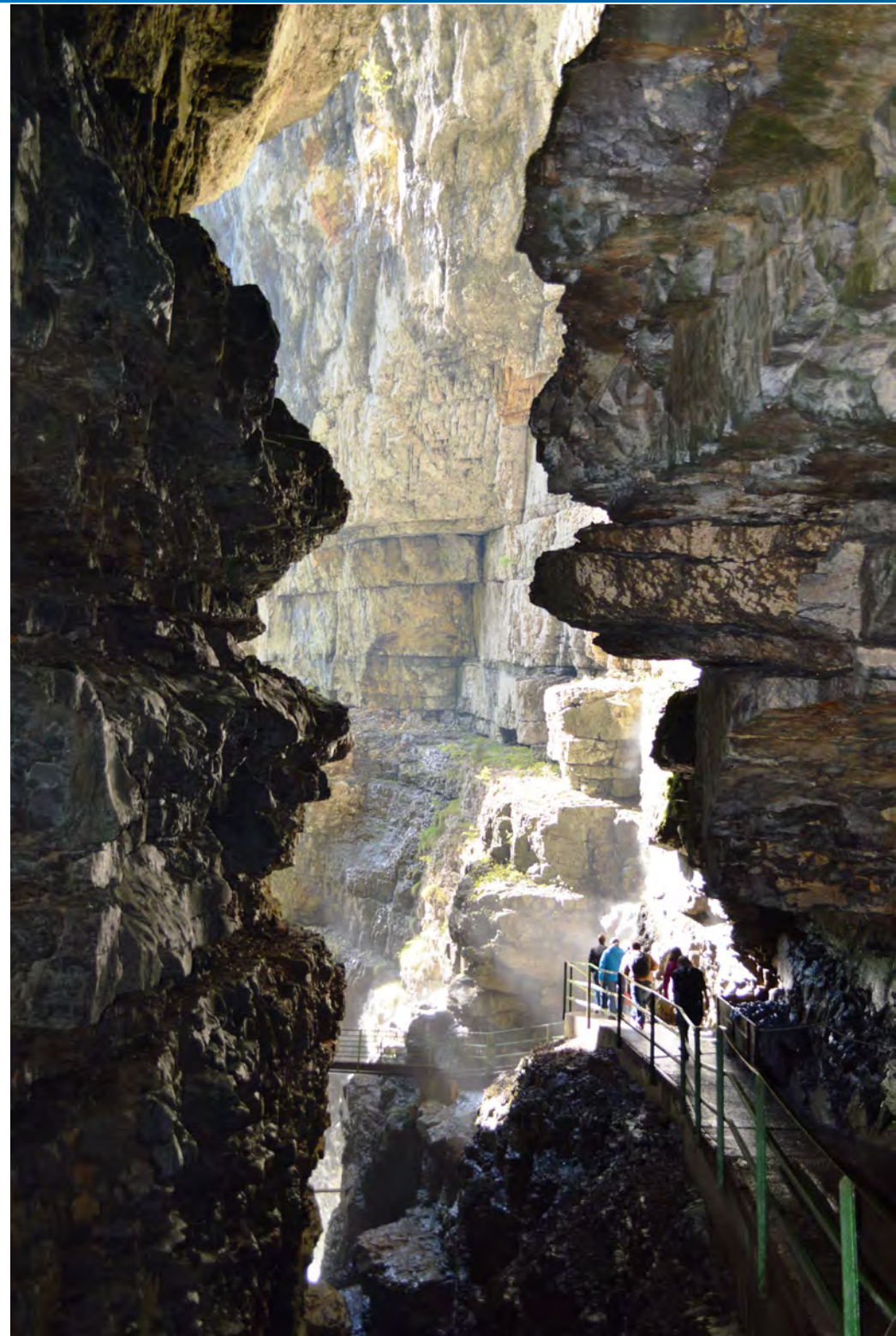

# COST OF LIVING

**The average cost of living for students in Kempten is approx. 700 € per month**

**>> cheaper than in many other cities in Germany**

**To give you an idea:**

Rent (including heating, electricity)	230 – 300 €
Phone, Internet, TV and Radio	40 €
Food	200 - 250 €
Health insurance (non-EU students only)	100 €
Books, clothing, miscellaneous items	120 - 150 €
Excursions, food, culture and travel	? €

**For students of Kempten University:**

- Subsidized meals / drinks in the canteen (about 2.50 – 3.50 € for a meal)
- Wide range of sports activities for only 7.50 € per semester
- No tuition fees, only semester fee of 92 € per semester

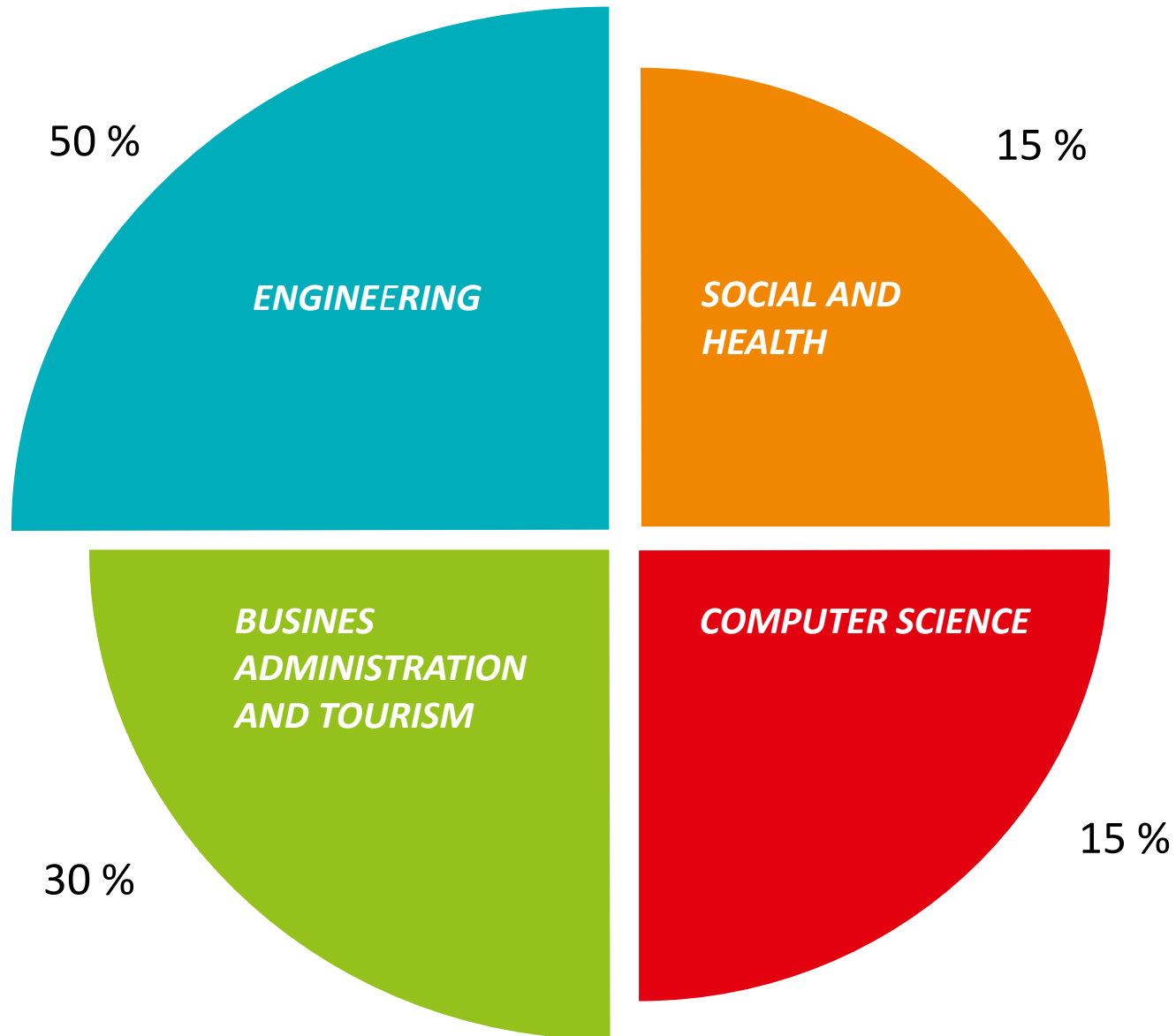

<b>Winter semester</b>	
Application deadline	31 May
Arrival, meet & greet service, moving into accommodation arranged by the International Office	maximum 3 days before Orientation Fortnight begins
Orientation Period	2 weeks before the semester begins (starting around 15 September)
Semester dates (Lecturing and examination period)	1 October – 14 February Examinations during the last 3-4 weeks of the semester
Semester break	15 February - 14 March

<b>Summer semester</b>	
Application deadline	15 November
Arrival, meet & greet service, moving into accommodation arranged by the International Office	maximum 2 days before Orientation Fortnight begins (Earlier arrivals are not possible)
Orientation Period	2 weeks before the semester begins (starting around 3 March)
Semester dates (Lecturing and examination period)	15 March - 31 July Examinations during the last 3-4 weeks of the semester
Semester break	1 August - 30 September

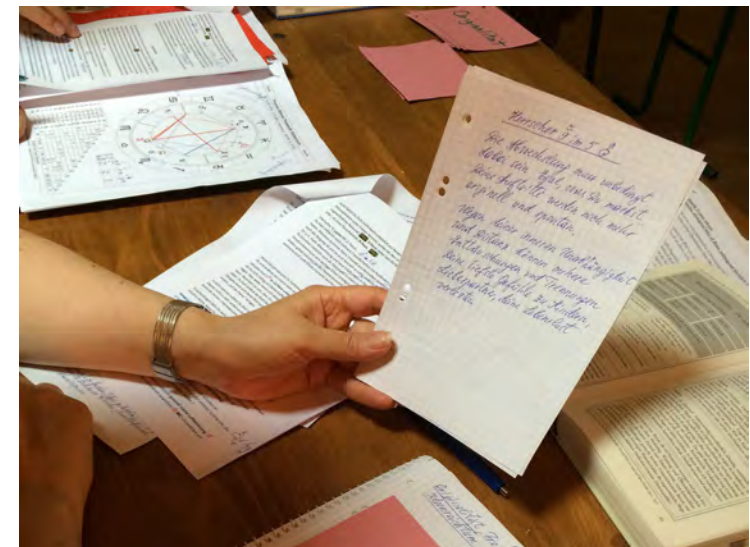
# CENTRE FOR WRITING AND COMMUNICATION

- Picnic, barbecue

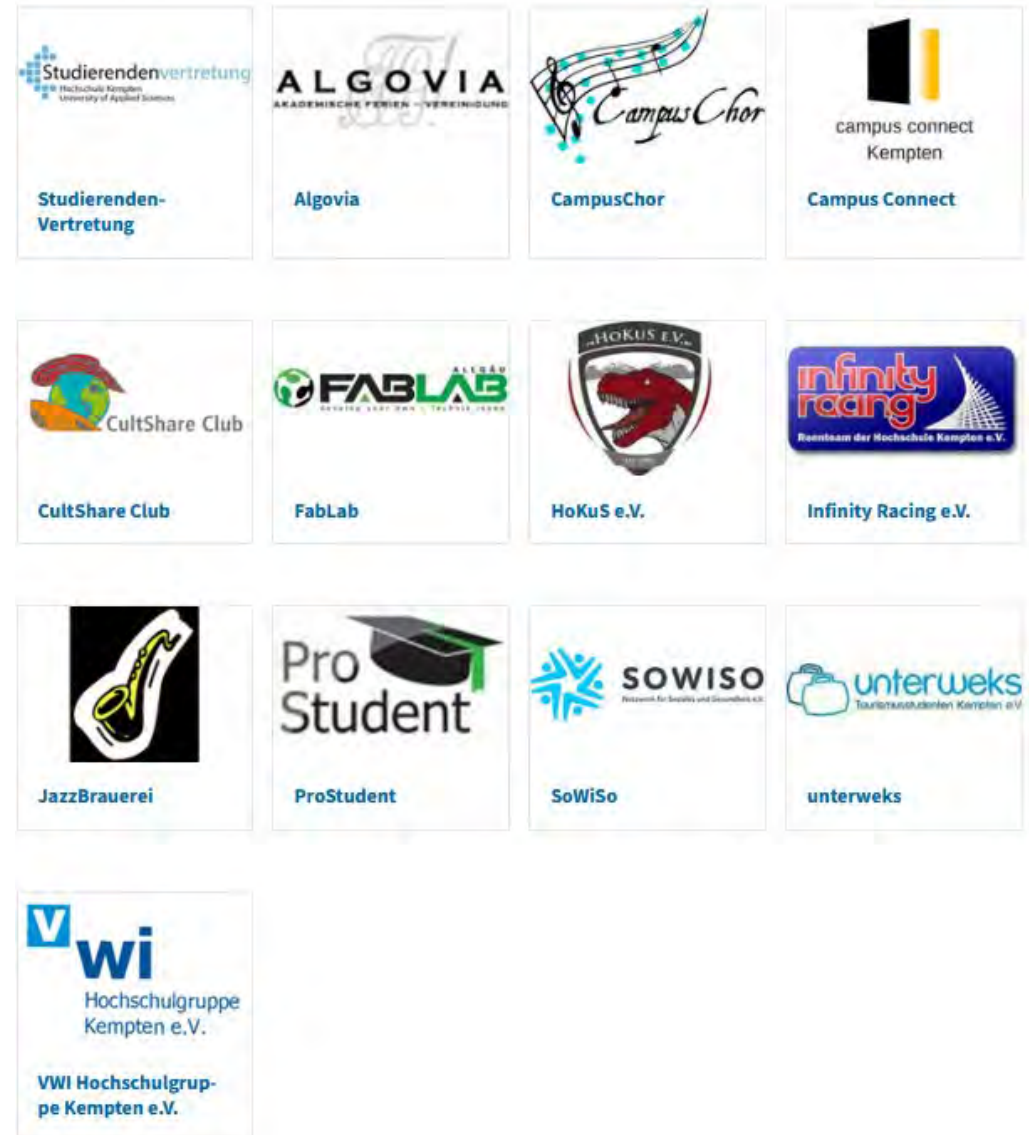


# STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS
